End Chap 12, grand finale of the epistle main themes

4 main elements throughout the epistle

Vss 12:18-24 – Theology – NC vs OC, Jesus vs Moses, Grace of Mt Zion vs Law of Mt Sinai

II A Warning (Heb 12:25-27a)

(Heb 1:1-4; Zech 7:11; 2Tim 4:4; Hag 2:6-7; 2Pet 3:10-13; 2Thess 1:7-10)

To those who may be unbelievers, potential apostates

Do not refuse Him who speaks; you will not escape

God's shaking

Come to Christ in faith

III An Assuring Promise (Heb 12:27b-28a)

(Matt 24:35; Rom 8:38-39; Heb 6:11; Heb 10:22; Rom 7:1-8:1; Heb 12:5-6; Jn 1:12-13; 1Pet 1:4-5)

We are receiving God's kingdom which cannot be shaken

Based on rock of God's Word, God's power, God's sovereign love

Assurance – diligently pursue it

IV An Exhortation (Heb 12:28b-29)

(Psa 107:8; Lk 17:11-19; Jam 1:17; Lk 7:36-50; Lk 18:9-14)

1st imperative: have grace = have thankfulness, gratitude

2nd imperative: serve God acceptably

Reverence and fear
